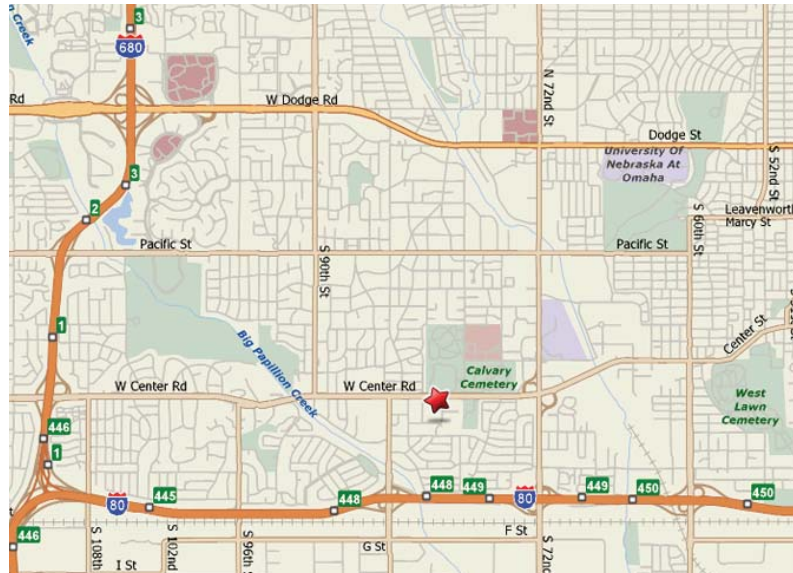

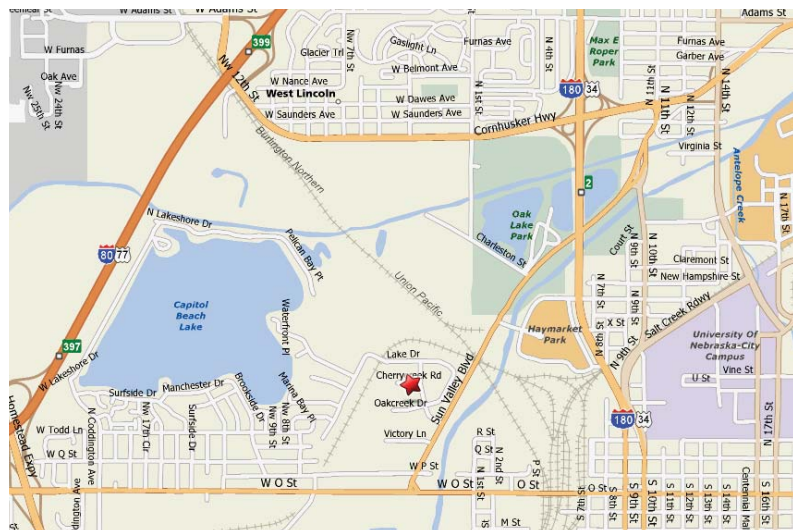

CONTINUING EDUCATION TRAINING

Presentations, discussion and interaction on concepts and science behind the pump sizing and selection, installation, dosing, and maintenance will be the foundation for these training sessions. Participants of all sessions will be able to apply their experience and knowledge about onsite systems to new issues. **Participants must attend Pumps and Controls prior to attending Dosed Systems.**

Pumps and dosed systems are allowed in Nebraska, and even required for systems with greater than 500 linear feet of distribution line (Title 124, pg 14-12). This information will be valuable for certified installers who must deal with large drainfields, or who cannot use gravity flow for systems due to lack of appropriate elevation changes.
