The 5 Steps to Develop Your Local WHP Plan

What Exactly is It?

WHP is a voluntary program which assists communities and other public water suppliers in preventing contamination of their water supplies. NDEE provides technical assistance and approval of WHP area boundaries and plans. Development of WHP plans may be eligible for funding from a Source Water Protection grant if part of a larger project.
